Explore the Imagine That! Museum in Florham Park. Borrow our pass that admits up to 4 people

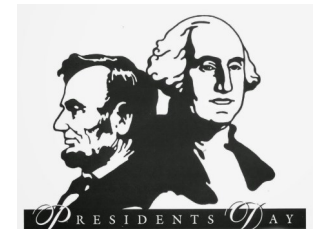
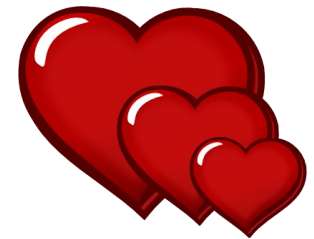
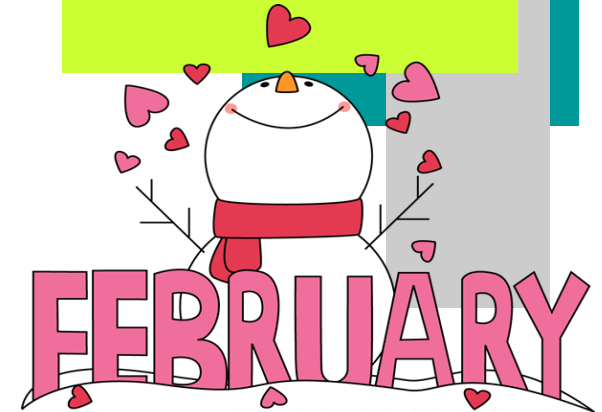
